

# **SITE NOTICE**

**Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended)  
Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) - Part 8**

**Applicant:** David Skene, Environment & Transportation Division, Dublin City Council

**Location:** The mouth of the Royal Canal in front of Spencer Dock, on the northern Campshires, adjacent to the Samuel Beckett Bridge, North Wall Quay, Dublin 1, on the river side of the existing historic Scherzer Bridges; which are protected structures, as are the quay walls.

**Proposal:** Pursuant to the requirements of the above, notice is hereby given of the intention to provide two lightweight steel bridges over the mouth of the Royal Canal into the Liffey, one bridge for pedestrians and the other for cyclists, both 12m long. The bridge closest to the Liffey will cater for pedestrians, connecting the existing pathway on the Campshires across the mouth of the Canal. The cycleway bridge will be closer to the Scherzer Bridges, and will integrate with the current cycle arrangement through some ground work around the bridge. The works will require repaving and some works on both sides, to address level changes, moving electrical control boxes associated with the Scherzer Bridges, enabling works to the quay wall (which is a Protected Structure) and removal of a number of trees to the west of the bridges to allow for a safe guided approach onto the bridges to segregate cyclists and pedestrians. This application relates to land within the North Lotts and Grand Canal Dock Strategic Development Zone.

Plans and Particulars of the proposed development may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy for a period of **4 weeks from Monday 24<sup>th</sup> September 2018 during public opening hours at the offices of Dublin City Council, Public Counter, Planning and Property Development Department, Block 4, Ground Floor, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8, Monday – Friday 09.00hrs to 16.30hrs.**

A submission or observation in relation to the proposed development, dealing with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area in which the development would be situated, may be made, in writing, to the **Executive Manager, Planning and Property Development Department, Dublin City Council, Civic Offices, Wood Quay, Dublin 8**, before **16.30hrs on Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> November 2018.**
